
From September 9, Cargonet will start its new transport offer with a direct route from Oslo to the port of Gothenburg. The port of Gothenburg has a clear vision and a clear goal of becoming one of the world's most competitive ports, one of the key factors to securing them the award as Sweden's best logistics locations. An award that they have won 18 years in a row.

With its strategic location on Sweden's west coast, about 70% of Scandinavia's population lives within a radius of 500 kilometers. Around 60 % of the total container volume in Sweden passes through the port of Gothenburg. Every day, the train tracks at the port are trafficked by about 70 freight trains, which gives the Scandinavian companies easy access to their respective market.

With numerous investments in environmental projects, new port areas and internal infrastructure, the port of Gothenburg shows its ambitious vision and is contributing to making a mark on the sustainable and competitive logistics solutions of the future. These investments include a completely new port terminal of 220,000 m², a new rail-connected transshipment terminal, and a port-connected logistics park of 1 million m².

Cargonet share the port of Gothenburg's clear vision for the future and we want to be part of offering our customers a sustainable transport solution that opens the door to increased flexibility internally and externally towards its customers.
